DUTIES & DESCRIPTION

The American Recovery & Reinvestment Act (ARRA) Sub-Committee of the Lackawanna County Workforce Investment Board, as convened and implemented on June 22, 2009, will provide oversight and guidance in the overall implementation of any/all ARRA programs and activities supporting the vision of the United States government for improvement of national economic conditions through infusion of funds directly to the citizens of local areas in the areas of provision of direct training and/or retraining opportunities; supportive services provision; testing and assessment; skills alignment with local and regional job openings; job search and development assistance; and coordination of all activities to align best practices promoting growth of the local labor market. The ARRA Sub-Committee is charged with ensuring the **accountability** and **transparency** of expenditure of **all** ARRA funds across specific funding streams that include adult, dislocated worker and youth populations. All actions taken by this Committee will be recorded and presented to full-Board at Quarterly Meetings for final review and approval.
